**LAST YEAR:** Concordia erased a 3-2 deficit in the second game against Hamline last year, posted a 13-run fifth inning and came away with a split in their doubleheader with the Pipers in St. Paul. HU won the first game 7-2 before the CC offense exploded in the finale to win 18-3. The hero of the day for Concordia was senior **Scott Schumacher** who earned a complete-game victory in the second game and also cranked out a grand slam in the decisive fifth frame. The Cobbers hit five home runs in the series with four of the five coming in the nightcap. In the opener Hamline touched up Cobber starter **Eddie Masee** for four runs in the first inning. CC would never be able to dig out of that hole as HU never let Concordia get to within two runs. That came in third inning when **Kyle Johnson** hit a home run in the top of the inning. The Cobber comeback would be silenced in the fourth and fifth innings when Hamline scored once in the fourth and then two more in the fifth. One of the turning points in the game came in the top of the fifth when CC loaded the bases with only one out. Johnson then popped up the first pitch behind second base and the Cobber rally would die one batter later after a foul out. Piper starting pitcher **Matt Mullendore** went the distance to pick up the win. The second game started just like the first as Hamline scored three runs in the first two innings and even took a 3-2 lead into the fifth inning. That's when Concordia took control of the game by plating 13. In the inning the Cobbers scored 13 runs, seven of which were unearned, knocked out 10 hits, had a pair of long balls and sent 18 batters to the plate. Schumacher started the barrage by hitting a grand slam after an error helped CC load the bases with one out. **Tony Emmerich** also hammered out a dinger in the inning.

**SERIES STARTED:** 1961

**SERIES SYNOPSIS:** The Cobbers' win in Game 2 last year snapped a six-game losing skid at the hands of the Pipers. The last time that CC had beaten Hamline before 2009 was back in 2006 when they won the opening game of the series in Moorhead. In that season, CC needed to sweep HU to get into the playoffs but Hamline was able to come away with a 2-0 win the second game and earn their first-ever spot in the postseason. Concordia owns a 13-5 record against Hamline in the last 18 games played in Moorhead.

## LAST GAME RECAP

**Concordia 2 at U. of Minnesota 4**  
Concordia gave up a pair of runs to the University of Minnesota in the sixth inning, which broke open a 2-2 tie, and ended up losing 4-2. Both teams had seven hits in the game as Concordia squared off against a Division I opponent for the third straight season.

Concordia grabbed a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning and then regained a 2-1 lead in the fourth before giving up a single score in the fifth and two more in the sixth to close out the scoring. The Cobbers got on the board in the first inning when **Dan Wackler** hit a double to left field and then scored on a two-out single by **Nick Lewis**. For Lewis it would be the first of his three hits and two RBI on the night.

After conceding a run in the bottom of the second, Concordia took a 2-1 lead in the top of the fourth when Lewis doubled home Wackler from second. The pivotal part of the game came in the remaining half inning. With runners on second and third and no outs, the Cobbers failed to score another run after a ground out to third base and then an inning-ending double play killed the Concordia rally after **Adam Johnson** was hit by a pitch. The Gophers tied the game in the bottom of the fifth on an unearned run after a steal of second. Minnesota then claimed the win by getting two runs in the sixth on three hits and a sacrifice fly.

Besides Lewis, the Cobber hits came from Wackler, **Jake Krause**, **Michael Carlson** and **Jordan Doschadis** who all had one base knock. Carlson was 1-for-2 in the game and now leads the team in hitting with a .389 average. On the mound, Chris Fellows started the game and pitched the first 2.0 innings. He gave up one hit and struck out one. Unfortunately his lone hit was a solo home run in the second inning. Johnson pitched the third and fourth innings, did not allow a run and gave up two hits. **Jake Torrison** then entered in the fifth inning and gave up an unearned run. **Zach Frappier** was saddled with the loss after giving up the two runs in the sixth inning.

**Andrew Skow-Anderson** and **Ryan Johnson** finished off the game for the CC staff. Skow-Anderson gave up one hit in the seventh and Johnson did not allow a base hit in the eighth.

## BUCKY WATCH

The watch for 600 is officially on! Cobber head coach **Bucky Burgau** currently has 595 career wins and needs only five more to become the 20th active DIII coach to reach 600 wins and the 32nd in the history of DIII baseball.

## COBBER NOTES

Today's game marks the first time that Concordia will play outside all season. The Cobbers have played their first 13 games in the Metrodome and have posted a 7-6 overall record. CC has outscored their opponents 59-50 in the first 13 games and has only given up more than four runs on four occasions. The strength of the 2010 Cobber team will be its pitching staff. Of the 13 games this season, 12 have been started by either a junior or senior and those starters have a combined ERA of 3.58. The starting staff has done their job so well that the relief corps has only pitched 8.1 innings in the first 13 games. Leading the way for the CC staff is junior **Jake Torrison** who has not allowed an earned run and is 2-1 on the year. **Chris Fellows** leads the team in wins with three. The other key factor for the pitching staff has been the emergence of **Ryan Johnson** as the team's closer. Johnson has pitched 13.1 innings, has a 1.35 ERA, has struck out 16 and has three saves. Last year the team leader in saves only had one. The other key difference with this year's team is the emphasis on speed and moving runners over. Concordia has stolen at least one base in all 13 games and already has 36 on the year. Last year CC only had 21 steals in their 31 games. Senior **Jake Krause** leads the "Go-Go" Cobbers as he is a perfect 10-for-10 in swipes this season... Concordia is 6-9 in its last 15 home-opening games. CC has not won a home opener since the 2004 season when they beat UW-Superior 12-3.

## PIPER NOTES

Hamline is currently 5-12 on the season and just returned from their six-game spring break trip in Arizona. The Pipers went 2-4 in Phoenix and beat Williams 5-4 on Wednesday in their final game of the trip. HU started the year 0-6 and also lost eight of their first 10...Hamline is led by junior outfielder **Tony Rogers** who is hitting .385 on the year.

## 2010 HAMLINE SEASON PREVIEW (Courtesy of the Hamline SID)

Hamline University head coach Jason Verdugo brings in one of the largest new classes in history of the program but sees strength in the youth of the team as the Pipers look to duplicate, and build upon, their 2009 success in which they reached the finals of the MIAC tournament. The Pipers enter the year after the graduation of 2009 MLB draftee Dan Kaczrowski. The shortstop led the team last year with a .393 batting average and had 26 RBI while hitting ten doubles and a team-high four homers. After collecting numerous All-MIAC, All-Region, and All-American honors in his career, Kaczrowski was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks last summer. First baseman/designated hitter Bill Sand represents the only other loss to graduation that the Pipers suffered this year. Sand hit .333 and knocked in 32 runs last year for Hamline.

The Pipers will see a lot of familiar faces in the field and at the plate, as Tres Humerickhouse (Jr., Farmington, Minn.), Andy King (So., Fort Myers, Fla.), J.D. Modrynski (Jr., Lakeville, Minn.), Tony Rogers (Jr., St. Michael, Minn.), Alex Buresh (Sr., Vadnais Heights, Minn.), and Cory Miller (So., Coon Rapids, Minn.) all return.

Modrynski returns as the primary first baseman for the Pipers after hitting .303 in 2009 and tallying 22 RBI. He is joined by Humerickhouse, who may see time at third base or shortstop but will also rotating with Buresh at designated hitter.

Humerickhouse hit .319 last year with 25 RBI while Buresh, who is one of four outfielders that Verdugo will rotate, hit .349 in 16 games played.

Rounding out the talented corps of outfielders with Buresh are King, Rogers, and Miller. King led the trio with a .306 batting average last season and drove in 25 runs while Rogers' fleet footwork on the base paths put him at second on the team with 11 stolen bases.

The newest faces on the field will be seen on the left side of the infield as a pair of first-years from Burnsville, Minnesota in shortstop Jacob Dahl and third baseman Dan Ellefson take to the field. Verdugo expects the talented duo to see a lot of time in the line-up early in their career.

The biggest question for the Piper roster comes on the mound, as Verdugo's pitching corps features youth. First-years Casey Benford (Mesa, Ariz.) and Evan Knutson (Faribault, Minn.) head up the in-coming class of pitchers upon whom Verdugo will be relying for a high number of innings.

Brett Bugielski (So., River Falls, Wis.) and Kent Huls (Jr., Apple Valley, Minn.) will lead the returning Piper starters on the mound this year. They combined for 29 appearances with 14 starts last year for the Pipers, posting a 9-5 record on the mound between the two of them.

Reliever Cass Kreitlow (Jr., Glenwood, Minn.) returns after posting a 4.15 ERA in an injury-shortened sophomore campaign. He looks to be a more valuable, and frequent, player out of the bullpen for the Pipers this year.

The steadiness in the battery for the Pipers will come from senior catcher Lincoln Hughes (Inver Grove Heights, Minn.), who sets up behind the plate for his final season after hitting .382 last year – second on the team. He drove in 24 runs and had an on-base percentage of .478 – tied with Kaczrowski for first on the team.

With a strong returning contingent and a very talented class of new-comers, the Hamline University baseball team will look to make a push for their third straight playoff berth and fourth in five seasons.
